Have you ever wondered what goes into maintaining the infrastructure in the Village of Bartlett? Come to the second annual public works open house and see what the streets, water, and wastewater divisions do on a daily basis to serve the community.

It's a great opportunity to catch up on the projects occurring around the village, and experience educational demonstrations related to the department's maintenance and improvements of vital infrastructure with new technology and tools.

The Bartlett Public Works Open House is on Friday, 9/19, from 2 to 6 p.m. There will be food, beverages, and various activities including:

- General tour of the public works complex and facilities including the Lake Michigan water receiving station and the streets garages.
- A guided tour through the water reclamation facility.
- Touch-A-Truck with the public works fleet of vehicles and various heavy equipment.
- Demonstrations from the streets, water, and the sewer divisions.

The public works complex is located at 1150 Bittersweet Drive just off Stearns Road. Hope to see you there!

W. Bartlett Road Closed for Pipeline Maintenance



Pipeline and energy company Enbridge has scheduled pipeline maintenance activities on a small section of West Bartlett Road between IL Route 25 and Munger Road beginning the week of August 18 and lasting for approximately 6 to 8 weeks.

During this time, West Bartlett Road will be closed in that area. Signs will be posted during construction notifying drivers of an alternate route. Parkway Tree Orders Accepted Starting 8/25



Bartlett's Parkway Tree Replacement program provides the opportunity for residents to select and purchase a parkway tree, with the village sharing 50 percent of the cost.

All trees available for order are 2 inches in diameter. The cost for residents is \$100 per tree. This price includes tree planting, a one-time mulching, and a one-year warranty. Limited quantities of each species are available, and all orders are filled on a first come, first served basis.

You are only eligible to purchase a tree if your property has an available planting space, as found on the interactive tree map on the village website. Planting is only done in the parkway, not on private property, and must be spaced 30 to 40 feet from other trees. Other restrictions, such as proximity to driveways, intersections, street lights, hydrants, underground utilities, etc. may occur. Final planting locations will be determined by the Village.

Orders for the Fall 2025 planting will be accepted online through the OpenGov permit system starting August 25. All orders and payments must be received by September 26. Use the link below for full details.

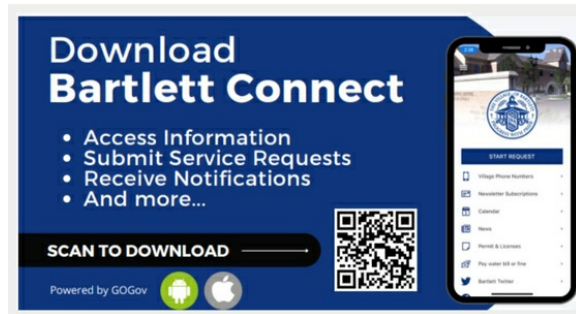


Bartlett has signage available for residents at village hall that reads "NO SOLICITORS INVITED."

Solicitors are required to avoid homes with this signage in accordance with the village ordinance. Solicitors who violate the ordinance are subject to a fine of \$50 to \$750.

Solicitors are prohibited from going door-to-door between 9 p.m. and 9 a.m., on Sunday and during national holidays. They must leave when asked to.

DuPage County officials, local legislators and other members of the community recently cut the ribbon on the DuPage Crisis Recovery Center (CRC), 115 N. County Farm Road in Wheaton.

Opening the week of September 2 for walk-in services, this one-of-a-kind behavioral health facility will have mental health professionals available 24/7 and will take all patients of all ages including those on Medicaid and those without insurance.

The CRC will be a destination for many individuals experiencing mental health emergencies. It has a mental health hub, a substance use hub and a children's hub. The first of its kind in the country.
